

Example:

Customer Support Representative | Helping software start-ups manage and grow their social media to drive more sales



3 ways to make your application stand out



Think about who you're applying to – keep it **relevant** and make it **personal**



Know that your application is more than just a CV – your email, video, cover letter, photo etc



Make sure your entire application paints a picture that sells you

5 ways to make your CV stand out



- Tailor your CV to the job
- Keep it short and succinct
- Provide specific achievements
- Update your contact information
- Ensure no typos or grammatical errors

How to get recruiters to work effectively for you?



Reach out effectively

- Update your CV and LinkedIn profile
- Look for recruiters specialising in the field you are applying to
- Check out jobs they are recruiting for/company's website for the latest jobs available
- Form a plan for your job search in partnership with your recruitment consultant
- Build trust and be honest
- Stay open minded and realistic



Things that don't help your application



What not to do

- Multiple applications for different jobs to the same company
- Generic applications that are obviously not tailored for the role
- Overly general requirements e.g. I'm interested working anywhere in Asia
